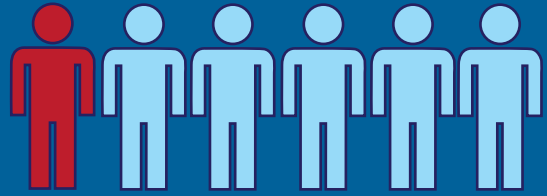

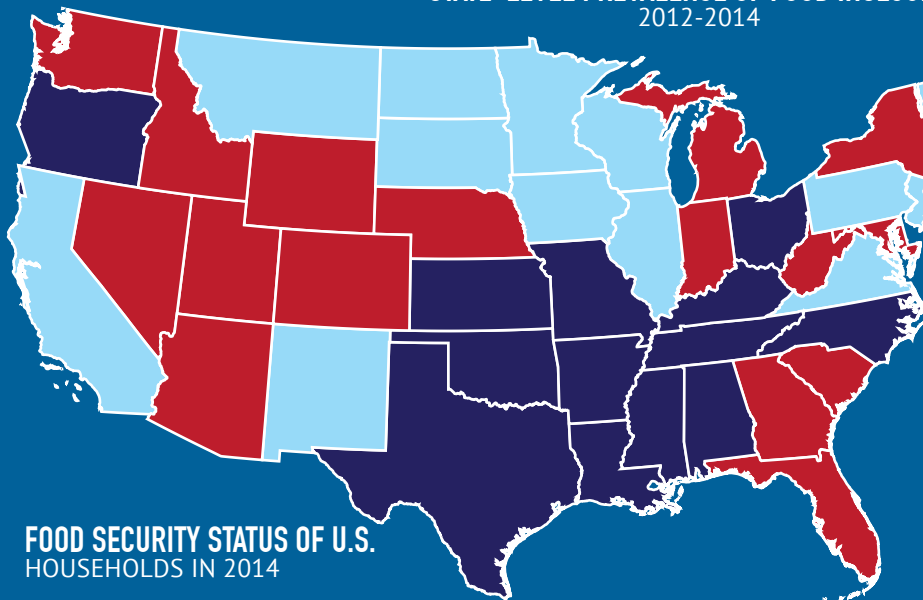

FOOD INSECURITY BELOW U.S. AVERAGE



At times during the year, households that are considered food insecure were unable to acquire enough food for all of their family’s members, due to economic distress.

FOOD INSECURITY NEAR U.S. AVERAGE



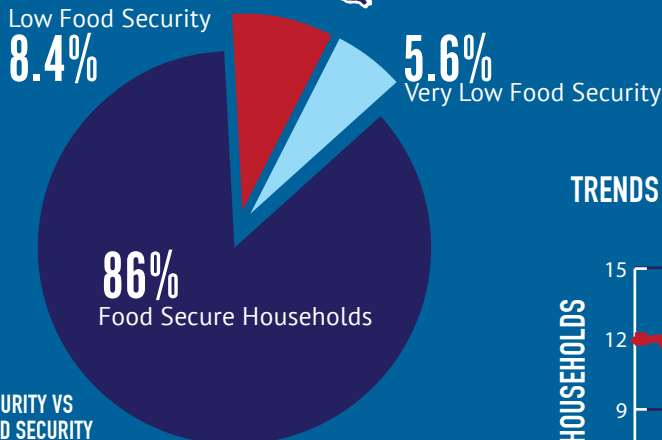
Food Secure homes, during all times of the year, have access to enough food for all members of their family.

FOOD INSECURITY ABOVE AVERAGE



In households that have above average food security, there is enough for all household members and more.

LOW FOOD SECURITY VS VERY LOW FOOD SECURITY

Low Food Security: households are able to obtain enough food to almost feed their entire families, but require Federal food assistance programs and help from community food pantries.

Very Low Food Security: households have access to these resources, but even with additional help they are not able to make it through a year without a disruption in food intake.
